### Memorial Day Order

by John A. Logan, Commander in Chief, Headquarters  
Grand Army of the Republic, Washington D.C. May 5, 1868

"The 30th day of May, 1868, is designated for the purpose of strewing with flowers or otherwise decorating the graves of comrades who died in defense of their country during the late rebellion... no ravages of time, testify to the present or to the coming generations that we have forgotten as a people the cost of a free and undivided republic... Let us, then, at the time appointed, gather around their sacred remains and garland the passionless mounds above them with the choicest flowers of springtime; let us raise above them the dear old flag they saved from dishonor..."
