Washington's February 22nd birthday was first celebrated as a holiday in 1885. In 1971 the Uniform Monday Holiday Act moved the holiday to the third Monday of February, and it has become generally known as President's Day celebrating all president's birthdays.

Eleven of Nebraska's counties are named after Presidents of the United States, including George Washington. These presidents join Civil War Generals, Nebraska Governors and others in the decorative frieze around the Capitol's second floor exterior. Who are the 10 other presidents with Nebraska Counties named after them?

(Hint: The number of their presidency: 2nd-3rd-4th-11th-13th-14th-18th-19th-20th-21st)
