The Lincoln Monument on the West Plaza of the Capitol was a project of Nebraska citizens to celebrate Abraham Lincoln's 100th birthday. Dedicated in 1912 on the grounds of the second capitol, the Lincoln Monument predates the Lincoln Memorial in Washington D.C. by 10 years.
